



Letter of Consent to Travel

Minors are not allowed in Mexico, by law, without a parent or a legal guardian. As a group leader, you become the guardian of all minors in your group making you legally responsible for their actions. *The Letter of Consent to Travel* is required by Mexican Law and must be notarized before arrival, and carried for the entire duration of stay in Mexico.
