

Letter of Consent to Travel

Minors are not allowed in Mexico, by law, without a parent or a legal guardian. As a group leader, you become the guardian of all minors in your group, making you legally responsible for their actions. *Mexican Law requires the Letter of Consent to Travel* and must be notarized before arrival and carried for the entire duration of stay in Mexico.

Your group can not cross the border into Mexico with Baja Christian Ministries without this completed form.
