



# Letter of Consent to Travel

Minors are not allowed in Mexico, by law, without a parent or a legal guardian. As a group leader, you become the guardian of all minors in your group, making you legally responsible for their actions. *Mexican Law requires the Letter of Consent to Travel* and must be notarized before arrival and carried for the entire duration of stay in Mexico.

*Your group can not cross the border into Mexico with Baja Christian Ministries without this completed form.*
